RANKING LIST OF ALL NATIONS CUP

The number of points per cup depends on the number of participants and the placement. An example: there were 7 participants, so the first place receives 7 points, the second 6 points, etc. The results of the last year are weighted by a factor of 4, those of the second-to-last year by a factor of 3, those of the third-to-last year by a factor of 2 and all others by a factor of one. Only the cups from 2010 onwards were included in the ranking, in 2009 one nation took part with 2 teams

MOLKKY RULES : ZOOM on MÖLKK-OUT and link for rules

Mölkky-Out is a game variant that can be used in tournaments to decide which team starts the next set. It is not part of the following set, so the order of the players may be different.

The skittles 6, 4, 12, 10 and 8 are placed in a straight row, each with an interval of one Mölkky length and normal distance (about 3.5 m) from the throwing area.

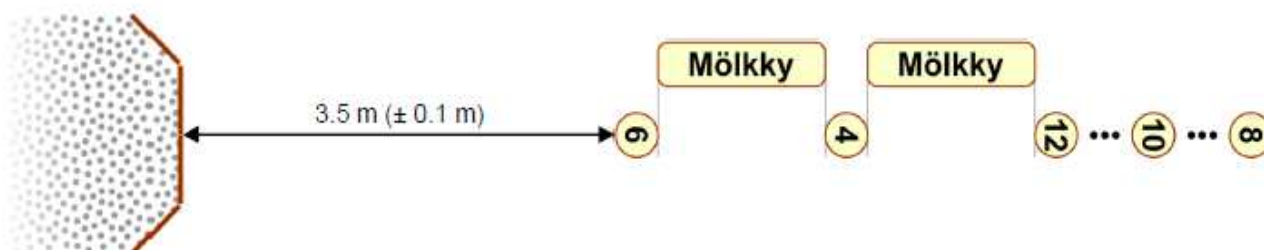
- The order of the players will be announced to the referee before the Mölkky-Out starts.
- A coin toss can be used to decide which team will throw first.
- In teams of 3 or 4 players each player has one throw.
- In teams of 2 players each player has two throws.
- In singles each player has three throws.
- The throwing order of the teams looks like this:
Team A first throw, team B two throws, team A two throws, team B two throws, team A last throw;

short form for teams of 4 players: A BB AA BB A
short form for teams of 3 players: A BB AA B
short form for teams of 2 players: A BB AA BB A
short form for singles: A BB AA B

- Fallen skittles will be put back to their starting position.
- Achieved points are counted together as usual.

The team with the higher score wins. Should there be a tie; each player gets another throw until one team has scored more points.
